Samanta Schweblin is the acclaimed winner of the 2022 *Premio Iberoamericano de las Letras José Donoso* for her artistic trajectory, establishing her as a trailblazer of contemporary literature. The translation of her debut novel, by Megan McDowell, *Distancia de rescate* (*Fever Dream*), was shortlisted for the 2017 International Man Booker Prize and won the 2015 Tigre Juan award and the 2017 Shirley Jackson Award for Best Novella, and was later adapted to a Netflix film in 2021. Her work has been translated into over forty languages, and has appeared in English in *The New Yorker*, *The Paris Review*, *Harper's Magazine*, *Electric Literature* among others. She has a forthcoming short story collection that will be published in the Autumn of 2025.
